CSC\_Public is a new email list that allows Cape St. Claire neighbors to more easily communicate with each other. Much like a town hall meeting, anyone may subscribe to the list, ask questions and answer questions. Any community related question or concern is relevant here. Over 260 residents currently subscribe to the list. The list features powerful anti-spam protections for subscribers.

- A new hosting service was chosen which yielded faster loading pages and easier updating.
- An automated import feature was added to make sure piers waiting and move lists were updated more frequently.
